Dear Jewish Home Assisted Living Family member,

Last week we informed you of the changes being made in the dining room at JHAL. When Bob Bardach and I met with the elders they were adamant (and very vocal) about their desire to continue to eat in the dining room. We tried to find a solution by spacing the tables at greater distances, limiting the number of people at tables to increase distance, removing any and all shared items, increasing the cleaning and sanitizing and monitoring compliance with these rules. The elders were not thrilled with these arrangements but they made their peace with it and complied. Friday, however, we received additional guidance from the New Jersey Department of Health. They broadened their restrictions to include both long term and residential care facilities and they recommended that all communal dining be discontinued. As a result, we are implementing that change at Jewish Home Assisted Living effective Monday, March 23, 2020. As of that date all dining will take place in individual apartments. The staff is working hard to manage the logistics of this undertaking to ensure that we deliver food as efficiently as possible.

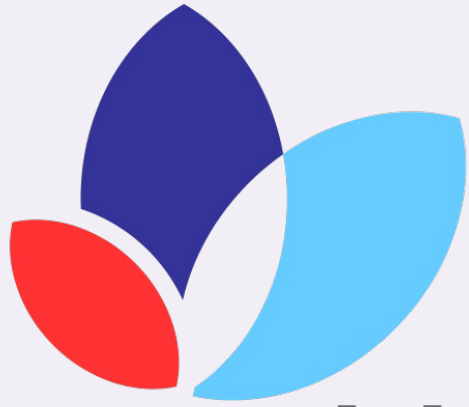
