Dear Family Member,

We continue our twice weekly testing of staff and elders across the Jewish Home Family. We are pleased to report that all of our staff and elders tested negative this week. Despite these results, we know that ongoing vigilance is vital and we continue with our focus on infection control, handwashing as well as cleaning and sanitizing.

Our final vaccine clinic will take place at Jewish Home Assisted Living on Saturday, February 27. We will complete the second round vaccinations of those who received their first injections on February 6. CVS will be on site to administer vaccines to elders, staff and more than 80 of our Essential Caregivers for both campuses. All of the Essential Caregivers who are receiving second vaccines have been contacted and are set for testing on Friday February 26 and vaccine the following day.

We are hearing that the retail pharmacy program is on the horizon next. There is some indication that there may be clinics through that program for long term care and assisted living facilities so that we can be sure elders and staff who are new to us receive the vaccine. There is no definite information on that at this point.

While we know that vaccinations are not easy to schedule, we hope that all of you are set up to receive the vaccine or soon will be. It is such an important step forward for all of us as we work towards returning to "normalcy." As well, we urge you to continue to exercise care, whether you have been vaccinated or not. Social distancing, handwashing and facemask use are still key to controlling the spread of this virus.


