Dear Family Member,

A number of us were on the Department of Health webinar this afternoon and we do have some clarification about visiting and other items. We are listing them below:

1. Quarantine: After medical appointments, if an elder is fully vaccinated, they no longer have to be quarantined after an appointment. As well, any new admissions or readmissions who are fully vaccinated do not have to be quarantined. The exception in all cases is if the elder was exposed to someone with COVID. In that case, quarantine will be required.
2. There will be vaccines made available on our campuses through our normal pharmacy providers. There will be J&J vaccines administered at JHR next week for any elder or staff person who has not previously been vaccinated and we expect that there will be additional clinics in the foreseeable future.
3. Visiting has been more opened, particularly for those who are fully vaccinated. Appointments are required. For the Jewish Home at Rockleigh, you may email sherman@jewishhomefamily.org and for Jewish Home Assisted Living, jhalecards@jewishhomefamily.org. Weekend appointments must be made by 5 pm on Thursday afternoons.
4. Indoor visits: Elders may have one indoor (or outdoor) visit per day. Indoor visits are limited to one person visiting. Again, appointments are required. Indoor visits may only be conducted in the elder's room or apartment. Visitors may not be anywhere else within the buildings.
5. Outdoor visits: Outdoor visits may also be scheduled one per day. Visitors may go to the elder's room or apartment and transport the elder outdoors for the visit. At JHR, outdoor visits will take place on the patio. At JHAL, outdoor visits can take place in the front of the building or on the patio. Outdoor visits are limited to one person coming in to take the elder outside where a maximum of two more visitors may join them.
6. Visiting hours are 9:30 am-8 pm at the Jewish Home at Rockleigh and 10 am- 6 pm

at Jewish Home Assisted Living.

7. Compassionate care visits will continue to be handled separately at the discretion of the clinical staff on each campus.
8. Visitors must wear properly fitting facemasks and must keep their masks on for the duration of their visit.
9. Visitors are asked to present evidence of full vaccination (you can show your card or a photo of your card). Unvaccinated visitors are asked to present results of a negative COVID test that was done within the last 7 days. If you cannot obtain a test, JHR offers courtesy testing Monday- Friday from 10 am-noon and weekends from 10-11:45 am. JHAL will offer testing on Mondays and Thursday from 10 am until noon. If you have had COVID within the last 90 days, you are not required to present a test result.
10. You must fill out a [visitor information form](#) prior to your visit and a copy is [linked here](#) as well as [available on our website](#). Essential Caregiver applications will no longer be required. If you have already completed an Essential Caregiver application you do not need to complete this form.
11. Every visitor and each elder who is able will be required to sign an informed consent prior to the visit. Current elders have informed consent forms on file. Elders do have the right to refuse any visit.

We are delighted to be able to accommodate more visitors and to reunite elders with their families. While there are still limitations and requirements, this does feel like a significant step forward.


