Dear Family Member,

We are happy to report that our COVID testing results, for elders and staff on both campuses, continue to be negative. We are also happy that we were able to administer additional vaccines this week through the partnership with Pharmscript, the pharmacy we use at JHR. Elders and staff who had received first doses of the Pfizer vaccine were able to have their second doses yesterday and we will have ongoing vaccine clinic opportunities to ensure that new admissions and new staff have the opportunity for this all-important protection.

Our increased visiting has been going well and elders are so thrilled to see their families again. The nice weather is facilitating outdoor visits and we have had many visitors, both inside and outside. Just as a reminder—only one visitor is allowed in an elder's room or apartment and you may not be anywhere else in the building. For outdoor visits, one person may come in and take the elder outside where up to two other family members may meet them. In addition, you must wear a facemask and practice social distancing. Please be sure that you understand and comply with these requirements.




